How to Submit Your Proposal - Due 3/31/11

(NOTE that we will accept proposals AFTER the deadline to be considered where there are conference program needs, and/or to be put on a waiting list for potential cancellations. The TIMELINE for proposals is designed to be able to promote the conference details before summer vacations). Forum sessions will include entrepreneurship symposia, panel discussions, demonstrations and individual presentations organized as 50-minute sessions. Submit your proposal in Word format or as content of an email, and e-mail it directly to the Consortium for Entrepreneurship Education at cashmore@entre-ed.org. We encourage use of PowerPoint, classroom videos on CDs, and user-friendly handouts. **We will confirm receipt of your proposal assuring your email was received.**

The proposal abstract MUST be no more than one typed page in length and MUST provide the following information which will be reproduced on our website and/or used in the conference:

1. **Title of presentation** (all caps)...short and catchy to attract an audience.
2. **Name**, position, organization, address, email, web page, and phone number of presenter(s).
3. **Focus of the objectives** and program content.
4. **Abstract describing** purpose and content of the conference presentation. Provide details of experiences and ideas that can be replicated by conference participants (2-4 paragraphs maximum please).
5. A short bio on the presenter(s) and description of the organization represented. (1-3 paragraphs maximum)
6. REQUIRED: A brief program description of one or two-sentences to be used in the conference program.
